The Southington Education Foundation (SEF) is a local, non-profit organization committed to supporting educators in providing students with innovative and enriching learning experiences beyond what the district can financially support. Since 2009, we have distributed over \$300,000 for various programs, grants, scholarships, and sponsorships to benefit students, PreK-12, as follows:

- \$144,000 for programs such as \$80,000 in funding for the Science at Slopers program, and initiation of the Southington MS/HS-Central CT State University (CCSU) Collaborative to increase interest in Science, Technology, Engineering, or Math (STEM) courses;
- \$150,000 in mini grants for teachers representing every school across the district, including the Karen Smith Academy (see website for full listing);
- \$14,000 in scholarships for SHS seniors pursuing careers in STEM, Visual and Performing Arts, or community/civic involvement; and
- \$11,000 in sponsorships for extra-curricular activities such as the Robotics Team and Town Spelling Bee.

On Friday, May 5, we will be celebrating 14 years of service at our signature event, the **Spring for Education Gala**, at the Mountain Room at Mount Southington, from 6-11pm. This event helps us raise funds through donations of live and silent auction items, as well as generous fiscal contributions from sponsors like you.
