Third-Grade arts Initiative: Dawn presented a collaborative grant opportunity with the NB museum of American Art, SEF, Foundation of Greater New Britain, and the Southington Public School System. This 3rd grade initiative will include trips to the New Britain Arts museum, artist in residence program, student art show at the museum, and will be integrated with the social studies curriculum. Chris Boulanger is seeking information to include in this national arts grant application for up to \$100,000. We can apply for a \$25,000 grant. If received we would be responsible for 50% of the remaining cost with the Foundation of Greater New Britain. \$12,500 is our proposed max. We are looking at a submission deadline of August 8th.
