# A. Approval of January Minutes

### 1. Grant Committee Report – Denise

- a) Winter Grant Book Tastings: Read, Rejuvenate, and Refuel Your Read Alouds
  - The blinded grant application was approved by committee after suggested revisions were made and it was resubmitted.
  - A detailed \$1,000 budget will be submitted after applicants conduct research to create an itemized list.

- The idea for this grant was conceived from a fall meeting with SEF members, which led to the concept of a much larger <u>program grant</u> currently in the works. It will serve as a starting point for the program being proposed.
- Ellen moved approval of awarding \$1,000 for the Book Tastings: Read, Rejuvenate, and Refuel Your Read Alouds grant, seconded by Katie. The motion passed unanimously.

## b) Literacy Program Grant Update - Michelle and Katie

- A meeting took place with the district literacy coordinator and lit specialists.
- o Possible title: Reading with Our Minds and Hearts
- o Funding will be sought from the *Barnes* as well as *Main Street* foundations.
- The committee is looking into ways to incorporate family engagement and community involvement into the proposal.
